### Eric Lebofsky Artist Statement

These drawings are the byproduct of my desire to process, concretize, and excrete the ephemera of my waking life. Like a Cole Porter song, they toggle high and low and evade the colossal in favor of a local, genteel, and fundamentally humanist vision. Humor is the key which unlocks nodes of experience, imagined histories, and glitches in the program of daily existence.
